Dear US TAG Members,

Per a ballot by the US TAG to TC 100, ANSI was notified on January 16, 2020 that the US TAG to TC 100 is operating solely under the Model Operating Procedures (MOP) for USNC/IEC Technical Advisory Groups. Per the ballot and the notification, quorum and voting eligibility are defined as follows:

Quorum. Quorum for the TC 100 U.S. TAG is 50% of eligible voters. For a ballot to be valid, at least 50% of eligible voters must return a completed ballot. For a meeting to obtain quorum, at least 50% of eligible voters must be present.

Voting Eligibility. New members are eligible to vote when they first join the TC 100 U.S. TAG. To maintain voting eligibility, a TAG member must not be absent from 3 consecutive TAG meetings and must return 50% of the ballots over a given six-month period. A TAG member who has lost voting privileges can re-gain them by attending a TAG meeting and by returning 50% of the ballots over a given six-month period.
